Natural gas costs an average of \$720 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,200 per year.

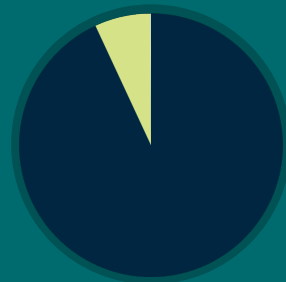

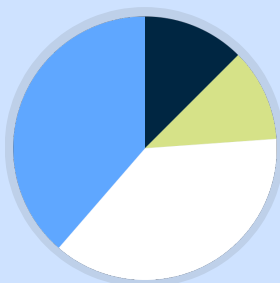

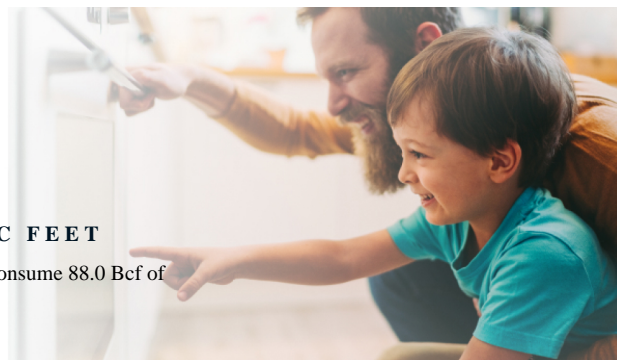
