Natural gas costs an average of \$460 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,100 per year.



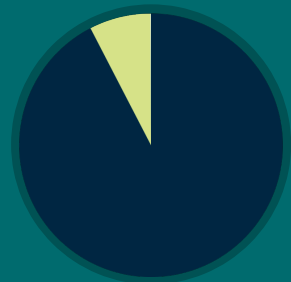

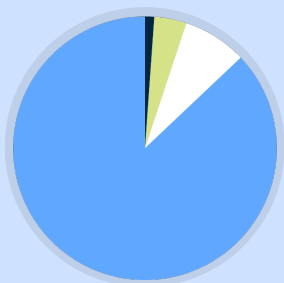

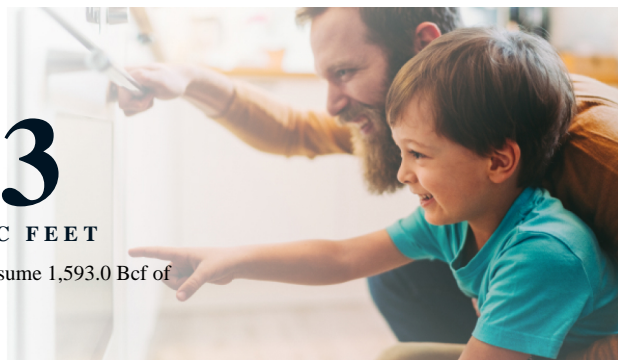
