

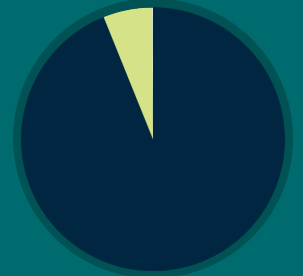
Natural gas customers save an **average of 28%** in Louisiana.

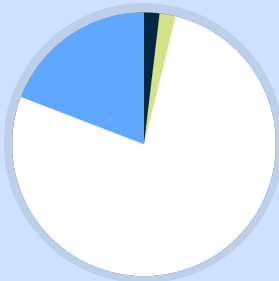

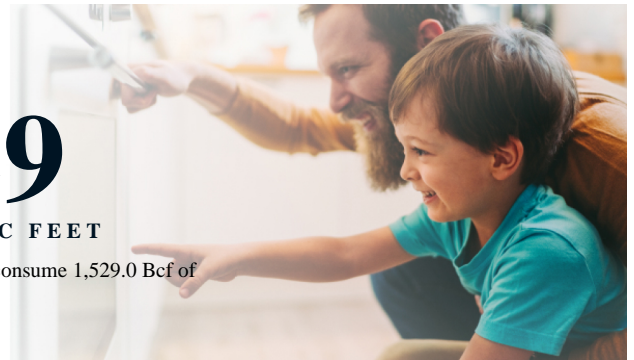
