Natural gas costs an average of \$650 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$900 per year.



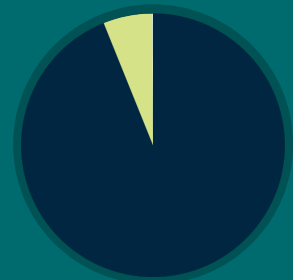

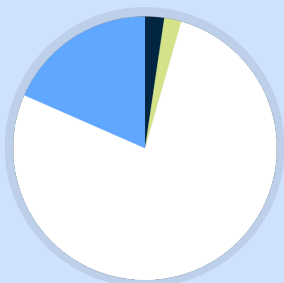
