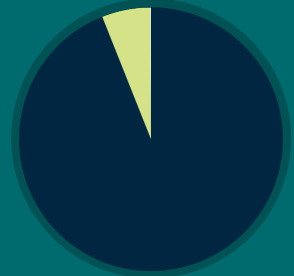

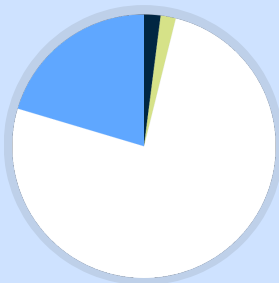

CONSUMPTION COMPARISON

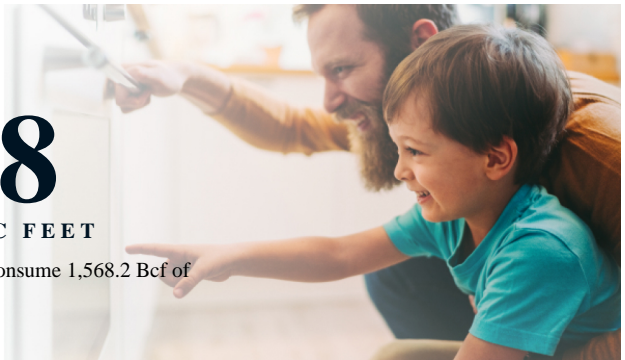
