Natural gas costs an average of \$850 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,250 per year.



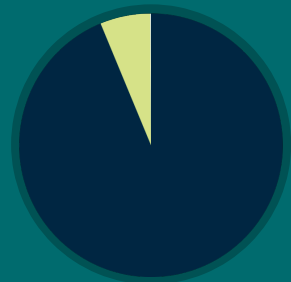

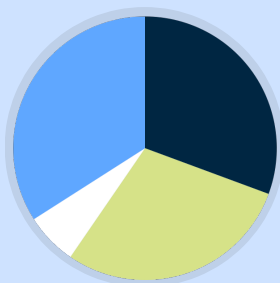

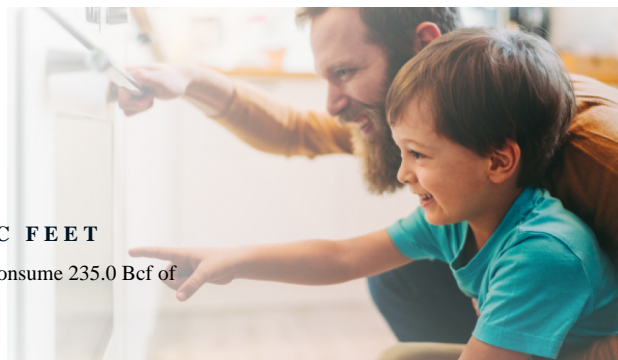
