Natural gas costs an average of \$600 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,200 per year.



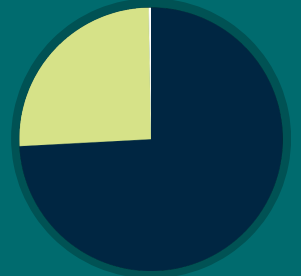

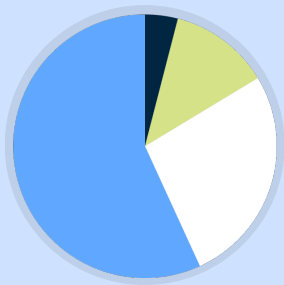

CONSUMPTION COMPARISON

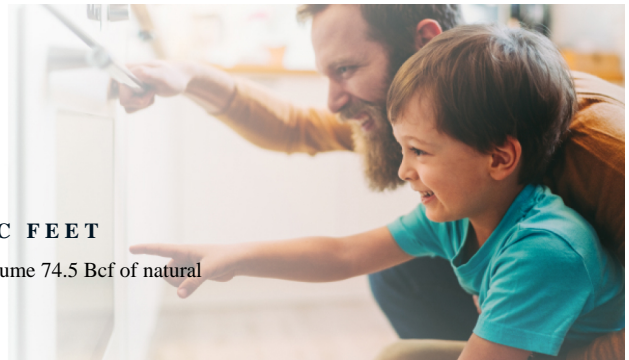
