Natural gas costs an average of \$700 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,000 per year.



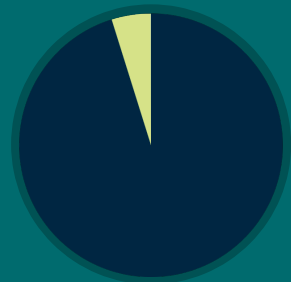

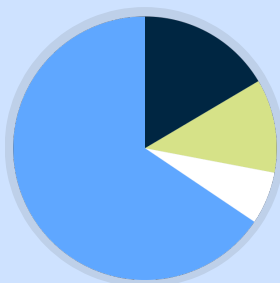

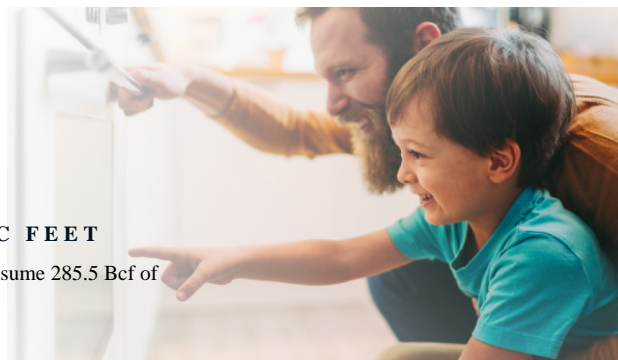
