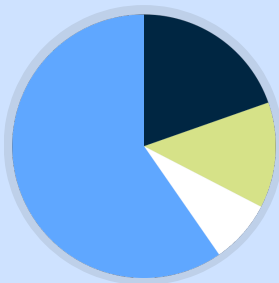

### CONSUMPTION COMPARISON

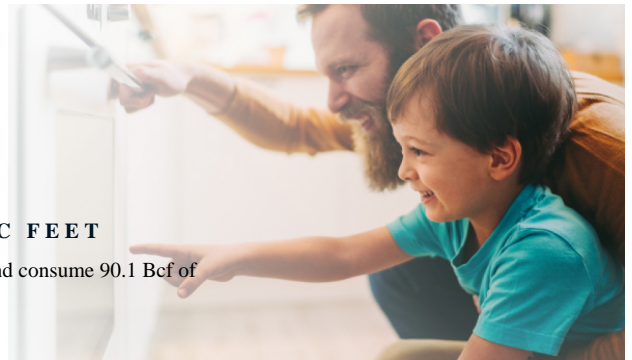
