Natural gas costs an average of \$583 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,100 per year.



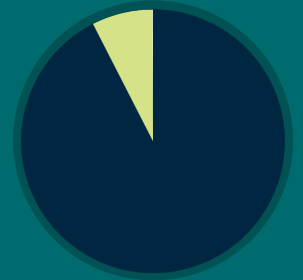

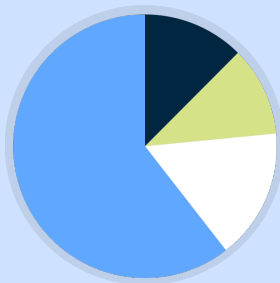

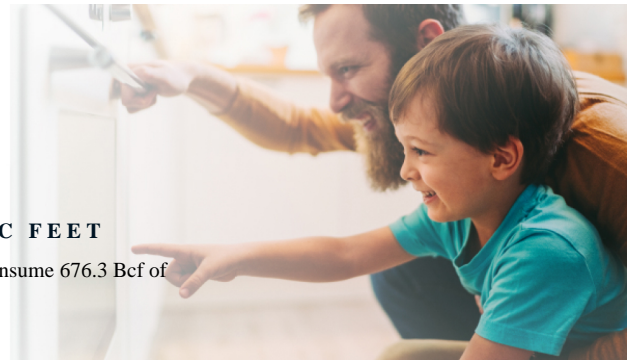
