By a two-to-one margin, Americans oppose banning the use of natural gas.

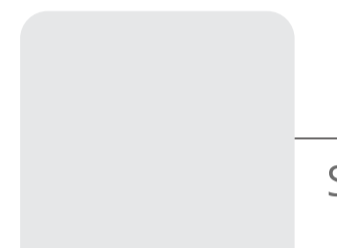

of Americans are concerned that a ban on natural gas could increase the price of food at grocery stores.

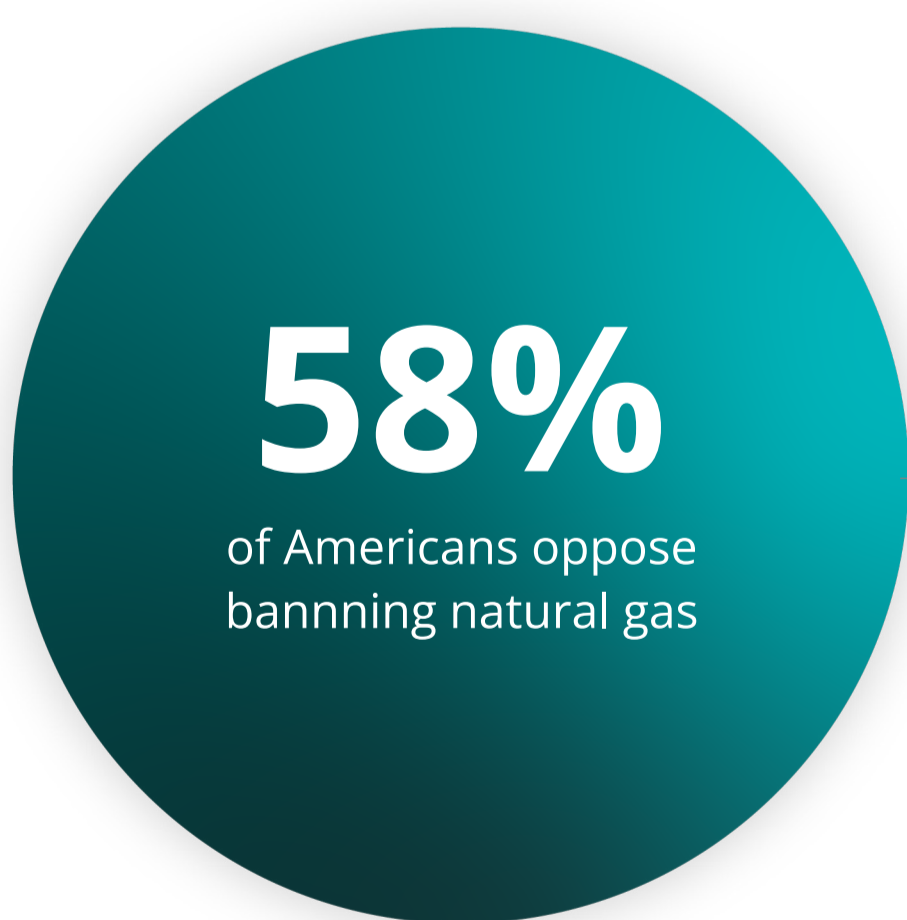

METHODOLOGY:

This poll was conducted between February 8-February 9, 2023 among a sample of 2200 adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of adults based on age, gender, race, educational attainment, region, gender by age, and race by educational attainment. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 2 percentage points.
