2 QUALIFICATION CHECK PRIOR TO PERFORMANCE

- (a) Prior to performance of a covered task, the operator should ensure individuals performing the task or those assigned to direct and observe non-qualified individuals performing the task are documented as being qualified, as required by its written OQ program.
- (b) Verification and documentation of qualifications should be conducted not only prior to the performance of a covered task being performed, but also upon a change or addition of personnel performing covered task(s).
- (c) Operators should also consider establishing a process for verifying the qualifications of the performed covered task.

<u>Example:</u> If covered work is ongoing, verify qualifications monthly to <u>assure</u> ensure that <u>qualifications are still valid.</u>

- (d) When verifying qualifications, the operator should perform the following.
 - (1) Identify the covered task(s) to be performed.
 - (2) Identify who will perform the covered task(s) (check ID).
 - (3) Verify the individual(s) identified are qualified in accordance with the operator's OQ plan.
 - (4) If an employee does not have a qualification, verify that a qualified individual will be present to direct and observe the performance of the covered task performed by a non-qualified individual, as allowed by the operator's span of control policy for the task.
 - (5) Ensure qualifications are valid throughout the expected project timeline.
 - (6) Obtain proof of qualification(s) and document when the verification(s) took place.
