SUBJECT: Weekly Cooling Degree Day Data

COOLING DEGREE DAY SUMMARY

For the week ending July 11, the weather in the United States was 1.2 percent cooler than last year and was 16.9 percent warmer than normal. All regions were cooler than last year except the South Atlantic, W.S. Central, Mountain and Pacific regions. All regions were warmer than normal. For the month of June, the weather in the United States was 8.4 percent cooler than last year and 13.1 percent warmer than normal.
