SUBJECT: Weekly Cooling Degree Day Data

COOLING DEGREE DAY SUMMARY

For the week ending August 1, the weather in the United States was 6.7 percent cooler than last year and was 10.7 percent warmer than normal. All regions were cooler than last year except the W.N. Central, W.S. Central, Mountain, and Pacific regions. All regions were warmer than normal except the New England, Middle Atlantic, and E.N. Central regions. For the month of July, the weather in the United States was 1.1 percent warmer than last year and 18.4 percent warmer than normal.
